Patrol:

Chief Baclawski reported that patrols were done for the season with the exception of the upcoming regatta on October 7<sup>th</sup>. The Chief noted that DEEP would be offering training this winter and it is only offered every other year. Currently there are seven officers and he suggests adding four more for training. There are currently two boat handlers looking to advance to officers. Former Chief Patrick Kilby expressed interest as staying on as a reserve officer. The Chairman thanked the Chief for a great season and job well done.

## Water Quality:

The July sample was taken and the August sample is scheduled to be taken later this week. This year's data hasn't been analyzed closely but a quick review indicates it is typical to previous year's.

#### Weed Harvester:

The harvester has been doing a good job and really started to make a difference once it was running full time. The two operators and truck driver have been putting in a lot of hours. However, it was noted there were large mats of cut weeds coming from over the dam. There is a bearing on the shore conveyor that needs to be replaced.

# Vessels and Equipment:

The boards were installed on the dump truck. The boats have been running ok.
