Patrol:

The LHAMP Chief, Ed Baclawski, reported on the patrols. A lengthy discussion was had about the issue with out of state jet skis driving recklessly and speeding. Board members presented videos of jet skis traveling too close to docks and even photos of damage to a boat from a jet ski collision.

The board asked the Chief to ensure the jet ski issue was being addressed, it was suggested that the radar be used more frequently to enforce the speed limit.

Water Quality:

Scott Ames reported that the first sample results were typical and that the next sample would be taken next week. Paul Jacobson presented his finding on Zebra Mussels. It was noted the number of live mussels was down significantly. The largest populations are closer to the Stevenson Dam.

Weed Abatement:

Scheduled for July 17th at 6:00am. A single boat will be in the water. There is a commitment from the Stevenson dam to hold back water for two days. The requested increase in coverage was not processed due to an error on the vendors part so the coverage will remain the same for this treatment. The weeds were surveyed on June 24th and will be surveyed again in October.

Vessels and Equipment:

Two props were put on order due to damage. The weed harvester needs to be put up for sale.
