Jim Olson reported that despite some setbacks the treatment went well. Unfortunately, we only got 8 hrs. of no flow from First Light. But despite that the Milfoil appears to be well managed. Tape grass could have been better but not bad. On a positive note, the permits are for three years.

Vessels and Equipment:

The Chairman reported the cavitation problem was corrected with a new prop. The issue with the stern light being dim still needs to be investigated.
