STANDING COMMITTEES:

Patrol:

The Chief, Brian Brainard, reported that the new patrol officer training and existing officer recertification classes were all complete. One officer was not able to attend the recertification training and as such will not be able to return as an officer but will remain as a boat handler. Patrols will begin next on May 29th and asked that the docks and at least one patrol boat is ready by that date. The new uniforms had arrived, and they were happy with the quality. Officer equipment will be issued to the officers prior to May 29th. The officers will sign that they received the equipment

and that they are responsible for returning it at the end of the season. All tax forms have been collected. The radar gun will be dropped off for calibration within the next week. The LHAMP policies and procedures has been updated. He also noted that DEEP Law Enforcement will be increasing their presence at Indian Well State Park. The Chief presented the list of officers and boat handlers for the 2021 season.

The Chairman asked for a motion to approve the list as presented.

Water Quality:

Scott Ames reported that the updated water testing quote was received. The cost of testing has not increased from last year. There was a slight increase in the cost of the courier to pick up the samples. Testing will begin on May 26th and conclude in October.

Weed Abatement:

Jim Olson reported the permits had not been received yet but were working their way through the system. He is confident they will be approved shortly. The first treatment will be July 13th and the second treatment will be August 3rd.

Vessels and Equipment:

Mike Stahl reported that the boats would be uncovered and prepped within the next week. At least on boat and the docks will be in the water by 5/28. The weed harvester has been picked up by the new owner.
